Paralympics 2022

The PARALYMPIC GAMES in Beijing, China are behind us, and Canada did well with 25 medals all summed up by Josh Dueck, Chef de Mission, "upon first look back, I was at a loss for words on what these BE22 Paralympics really meant... and after 21 days of rest and reflection, the rear-view mirror seemed more transparent. The Games were simply stated, friggin awesome! We came, we played, we returned home."

Josh Dueck, chef de mission of the Beijing 2022 Canadian Paralympic Team, was elected to the International Paralympic Committee Athletes' Council.

In a previous issue of Paralympic news the International Paralympic Committee officially announced that it is implementing a PLY post-nominal program to recognize the achievements and contributions of Paralympians.

What this means is that PLY can be added alongside the name of a Paralympian, similar to OLY for Olympic athletes, or post-nominals you are familiar with seeing like PhD or MD.

This celebrates Paralympians and our accomplishments as high performance athletes. Athletes can apply to receive the PLY designation by filling out an online form: https://db.ipc-services.org/sdms/hira/ply-programme and can start using it upon approval by the IPC.
