The Paralympics are underway taking centre stage in Paris (August 28th – September 08th) now that all the bugs are worked out from the Olympics. The 2024 Summer Paralympics, also known as the Paris 2024 Paralympic Games, and branded as Paris 2024, is the 17th Summer Paralympic Games, an international multi-sport parasports event governed by the International Paralympic Committee (IPC).

There are 184 National Paralympic Committee's involved, with 23 sports, 11 days of competition at 20 venues with



549 events with 4,400 athletes and with an estimated 3,000,000 plus spectators. With each set of games there is more and more publicity and

Tires, Tubes, Rim Strip

The tires end users get often depend on which ones come standard on wheelchair order forms. What ends up on wheelchair order forms may be the best around or simply make the most economic sense to the manufacturer. This is one of those pet peeves where we have order forms with lots of choices that allow for extra cost items.

The darling of tires is what works best for the individual and their personal choice. Schwalbe's Marathon Plus is hard to

beat with its long wearing compound, high pressure, and 5 mm of puncture resistance underneath the tread giving it the flat-less label for daily use products and their Right Run and Speed Air tires for sport.



Relatively new tires on the

market from OMOBIC include the Trailblazer, SpeedLite, and Gazelle are gaining in popularity with puncture resistance up to 3.5 mm underneath the tread. They are on some order

forms now and we can expect that the dealer network will be stocking them soon.

Although Spinergy is using all tires, they are distributing the IRC line designed for competition and featuring the Exeracer Pro with a silica and antibacterial rubber tread



compound that provides a balance between surface grip and low rolling resistance.



Primo has always been popular, along with Cheng Shing, and the Sentinel line. These offerings also have power chair tires and solid tires competing with Kenda for the widest range of products available.

Kenda was our first introduction to colored tires, and they have the widest

range of products available in this space crossing manual and power products. They have had a hold on court action Koncept, with Kontender. Kontester, Konstrictor, Pardeigm, and Hexon!

Most of these tires range from 20"(451), 22"(489 or 501), 24"(520 or 540), 25"(559), and 26"(571 or 590), 27" (622).





All of these companies provide tubes for sizes and each one has construction quality along with valve offerings. Like Schwalbe with their Aerothan TPU products, Omobic has ventured into the Thermoplastic Polyurethane area that has been in the bike industry for some time producing ultralight and extremely durable, easy to handle and to assemble product. The material is extremely flexible, resilient and heat/cold resistant, and is ECO friendly! Their snap-on rim strip is like Spinergy's, the best coming in most sizes and if it is not available

then Schwalbe's blue roll will do the job very well.

Abilities Expo 2025
