The new **MERIDIAN** ™ is getting great reviews from people using the product and those working in the industry as prescribing authorities. Our second shipment for 2006 is enroute and due to arrive this week (no, we did not sell the first 600 units for the Canadian market; the tractor trailer unit delivering the product was in a horrific accident and fire in the North Bay area which resulted in the whole unit being buried in a landfill). The **MERIDIAN**™ is ultra-light weight, has a dual chamber for enhanced positioning, two valves up front, pediatric



through bariatric sizing, available with and without the **WAVE™**, and designed to prevent sacral sitting! This product is recommended for people with ALS, MS, Spina Bifida, and particularly for quadriplegics. You can download a brochure here: <u>www.4rgk.com/downloads/Meridian_Brochure.pdf</u>

As per all other products (except the **ZOID**TM), you can order a regular or incontinent cover with no additional charge. Further to inquiries regarding the incontinent features, please note that there is a coating on the backside of the incontinence material that is sprayed on (non-latex) creating a waterproof barrier. It has tiny holes to allow humidity/perspiration to escape while not allowing water to penetrate. This light grey coating is mostly hidden by the reticulated foam that is sewn to the inside of the top panel of the cover. It is very important to note that latex is not used in any **VARILITE®** products and that the coating is a urethane base. The top and side materials are waterproof in nature by the weave design and the coating is additional reinforcement. The coating stretches with the fabric keeping the waterproofing intact.

There is no problem in affixing headrests to the back systems. The warranty that VARILITE® provides with the product covers drilling holes for a headrest and the VARILITE® PAL lateral supports. If holes need to be drilled, it is recommended that they be on the flat center panel as flush mounting is sturdier than attaching headrests to backs that have a rounded or contoured center panel. The Evolution™ Back has a flat center panel for accessories being added to the product. The PAL products have the same contour as the back itself with pre-slotted areas for the secondary supports.
