CAOT Conference in Montreal

Tanya Baglole, Communications Coordinator for the Canadian Association of Occupational Therapists has her work cut out for her with the 2006 CAOT Conference taking place in Montreal from June 1-3, 2006 at the Fairmont The Queen Elizabeth. The host committee is comprised of Daniel Bourbonnais, Johanne Desrosiers, Élisabeth Dutil, Isabelle Gélinas, Huguette Picard, Andréia R. Malisia and Pierre-Yves Therriault. The Chair of the Conference Scientific Program Committee welcomed everyone with a Conference theme that conveyed how occupational therapy is gaining momentum in developing evidence for occupation - the building block of the profession. She wants the Conference to be an opportunity for her colleagues to share their findings in this area and add to the growing body of evidence.

Their mandate, as the Conference Scientific Program Committee, was to produce a balanced program that meets the wide range of needs and interests of occupational therapists. The diversity of practice was extremely evident while reviewing the 399 papers submitted for presentation

at the conference. This year, they were very pleased to receive about 20% of the abstracts in French. Due to the high quality and quantity of submissions, the final selection of abstracts was difficult and their overall acceptance rate was 59%. This conference program offers sessions that address the latest practice, research, education and professional issues.

The pelvis is however rotated rearward with the tendency for increased lordosis, combined with poor pressure distribution.
