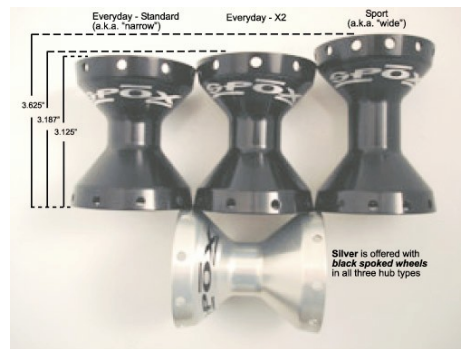

Spinergy Wheels

We have the largest selection of Spinergy Wheels in Canada for immediate shipping, complete with the desired push rim, setting, tires, etc. We often get the question of which axles to use with these and other wheels. RGK uses a 130 mm axle for all Spinergy PBO (polyphenylene bensobisoxazole fiber) and 120 mm axles for Spinergy Wire Wheels.

The most common Spinergy Hubs are: 1. Everyday Standard which has an overall width of 3.125 inches and a bearing spacing of 1.8 inches; 2. Everyday X2 which has an overall width of 3.187 inches and a bearing spacing of 2.3 inches; 3. Sport Wheel which has an overall width of 3.6 inches and a bearing spacing of 2.3 inches. As you can see with the two everyday hubs, the X2 has the inside bearing close to the edge of the hub itself whereas the other daily use offering has the bearing recessed ½ inch. Natural Fit Handrims LT

Natural-Fit and the Natural-Fit LT push rims have proven results for performance and efficiency, eliminating pushing on the tire, eases pain in the hands & wrists, and gives greater control when braking.

The Natural-Fit (top image) uses the original, larger profile oval. It offers 80% more surface area for gripping than a standard handrim and weighs just 26 ounces.

The Natural-Fit LT (bottom image) uses a reduced weight, smaller profile oval. The LT is designed for those looking for a reduction in weight or a smaller gripping surface (for those with smaller hands). The LT is more than 25% lighter than the original Natural-Fit; it weighs just 19 ounces (about 4 ounces more than a standard round-tube handrim).



Both the Natural-Fit and the LT fit on almost all standard wheels: * 22, 24, 25, & 26 standard spoke wheels * 24 Mags (6, 7, and 8 point) Spinergy and X-Core Wheels.
