Beijing 2008

Philip Craven, President of the International Paralympic Committee used the word "fantastic" on numerous occasions when talking about the Paralympic Games in Beijing. All reports suggest that the people of China touched the world and the world touched back; "it was superbly organized, all events well orchestrated,



and every athlete need was met and exceeded," said our Chantal Benoit, "and you could eat every meal as if you were in a different country! We did not even mind staging and spending half a day at the opening and closing ceremonies with 90,000 plus as the entertainment was seamless and riveting."

Although we had disappointing coverage of the games on television, print services had a little coverage and www.ParalympicSPort.tv gave us most of the highlights. It is unfortunate that in this day and age of streaming video on-line that we were not able to have more on demand coverage of the Paralympics.

Congratulations to the USA Women who emerged number one in wheelchair basketball defeating a strong German squad while Australia bettered Japan for the bronze. The Canadian Women ended in an unfamiliar 5th place, something that they have not seen in over 20 years (they had bronze in 1990 and 2004 and won gold at the World Championships (W) and Paralympic Games (P) in 1992 (P), 1994 (W), 1996 (P), 1998 (W), 2000 (P), 2002 (W), and 2006 (W). The Canadian Men missed on a three-peat coming up short against the Aussie's after squeaking by the USA in double overtime; the USA had nothing left against GB who took the bronze. Domestically, Canada is ready for an overhaul in this sport as the junior ranks are not swelling and that age group will struggle at the worlds next year. Changes will have to be made for both Canadian men's and women's teams to enjoy the successes of the past 20 years, whereas the USA men's and women's teams have a strong upside with up and coming athletes.


Ki Mobility at CSMC and REE
