The 2010 Chair Leader Event aims to raise awareness of the issues facing people with a spinal cord injury and other physical disabilities during the CPA's Spinal Cord Injury Awareness Month. Twenty MPs and Senators will use a Ki Mobility Tsunami wheelchair with a Varilite® Evolution, Stratus, or Reflex cushion for the day.

RGK announced the addition of a swing away footrest option on the RGK Maxima model allowing versatility for those users who want to stand in and out of their chair or

for those that simply need a swing away option to get closer to a transfer.

The system does not use a latch, lock, or lever to operate;



just a simple lift and rotate out to the side and the self location in the forward position makes relocation effortless.


This unit will come standard with height and angle adjustable flip up footrest

Gary William (Wilcox) McPherson CM, LLD (Hon) would be the official title, but we knew Gary (affectionally called Mother) McPherson who was a husband, a father, an advocate for people with a disability, a partner in growing one of the best wheelchair basketball organizations in Canada, a national leader in the wheelchair sport movement, a candidate for Leader of the PC Party of Alberta, an author, a social entrepreneur, and a host of other things including an ability to reciprocally call hundreds of folks friends!

His biography in the Sports Hall of Fames and with the Order of Canada will be changed to reflect his passing on Saturday May 08th at 63 years of age. We express our sympathy to his wife Val, daughter Keiko, son Jamie, and mother Dorothy and the rest of his family.

Mother will have a family gathering and cremation, and then there will be a life celebration organized later in June in Edmonton.

"Dr. Gary McPherson was an amazing Albertan with a unique courage and commitment to this province," Premier Ed Stelmach said in a statement Saturday. "He inspired all of us with his dedication and leadership as a tireless advocate for those who face daily challenges in this life."
