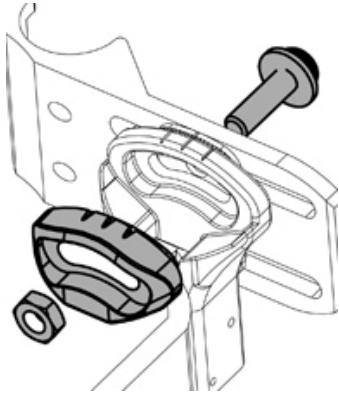
ADP Codes On-Line
