"Our website, live streaming, and social media platforms will serve to connect hundreds of athletes, coaches, and volunteers from around the globe. It will bring together

lifelong fans and newcomers to the sport. This is something we are very excited about," said Event Co-Chair Wendy Gittens.

501 (22") and the 540 (24") rims. We have had stock for the 559 (25") rims for some time now although they are folding tires as opposed to steel beaded. The thing to remember on these tires is that the profile changes

considerably with the 22" coming out to a height close to that of the K161 $24 \times 13/8$ tire and the 24" is close to that of the K192 $26 \times 13/8$.
