One of their projects is a basketball wheelchair called the "Spin Off." It is made out of steel tubing and weighs in at less than 30 pounds. It is a fixed frame unit with a fifth wheel, side guards, adjustable upholstery, foot rest, and looks remarkably like a Quattro with a fixed center of
