

- □ **March 27, 2012** Assessment info: What information counts when prescribing product and how do you get it?
 A review of what mat assessment data and critical measurements are needed to create a functional prescription.
- □ **April 24, 2012** Turning data into simulation: Learn to use your hands to determine shape and force. A review of how to turn the mat assessment data into simulation of shape and forces. Learn how to translate the determined shape into a cushion or back.
- □ **May 29, 2012** Friction/shear/pressure: How do these factors change your choice in the final shape and materials used in the product? A review of cushion make-up, considering the use of foam/air/gel with respect to shape and pressure management.
- □ **June 26, 2012** Backing it up: taking a look at back shape and its role in pelvic stability and trunk positioning to gain head and hand function.
- □ **July 17, 2012** Getting to the Finish Line: making the cushion and back functional within the chair A review of how mounting the system, seat to floor heights, and centre of gravity affect functionality.

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Rubber World

On January 25, 2012 a report out of Singapore referenced the latest rubber statistical bulletin and rubber industry report published by the International Rubber Study Group for October-December 2011 and it stated that, "Annualized global rubber consumption reached 25.8 million metric tons by the end of the third quarter of 2011, 6 percent higher than at the same point in 2010, reflecting a decelerating increase in the demand for vehicles and tires. Global synthetic rubber (SR) production was 7.5 percent higher than at the end of the third quarter of 2010, in line with the relatively strong growth seen in SR consumption supported by competitive prices, while the global natural rubber (NR) supply was 4.1 percent higher than at the end of the third quarter of 2010. Global rubber demand is forecast to reach 27.2 million metric tons in 2012. Global SR demand is expected to grow by 5.5 percent in 2012, while global



NR demand is forecast to rise to 4.6 percent in 2012. The global NR production is forecast to rise by 5.1 percent in 2012, driven by higher growth in normal production."

In the wheelchair world we use mostly SR partly because the pricing is better, but also because a lot of end user's have NR allergies; in particular, in the 1980's it became known that 73% of the spina bifida population had

negative reactions to latex (milky fluid found in plants – the latex in the rubber trees is the source of natural rubber) or NR products.

The Globe and Mail reported that the price of rubber jumped 20% in January 2012 as Thailand, the worlds largest producer of rubber, initiated a buying program on





speculation that there would be sustained global growth and increased demand for rubber products noting the soaring growth of the automotive industries in China and India. China has 35% of the global rubber consumption!

All this to say that we will likely see continued high prices for rubber products as someone has to pay for the daily commodity updates!
