The findings will be used to educate parents about the value of after school initiatives in increasing physical activity and healthy eating, to influence the decisions parents make about after school programs, and to help after school programs better reflect the needs of children with disabilities and their parents.

## Maintenance

It is always a challenge to keep your chair in good working order; we some how seem to take our rides for granted. A friend of mine sent this image before doing a bit of overdue maintenance.



Manufacturers produce a user manual and have a good portion of it talking about maintenance. In the case of Ki Mobility, the following is provided:

#### A. INTRODUCTION

1. Proper maintenance will improve performance and extend the useful life of your chair.

2. Clean your chair regularly. This will help you find loose or worn parts and make your chair easier to use.

3. Repair or replace loose, worn, bent or damaged parts **before using this chair**.

4. To protect your investment, have all major maintenance and repair work done by your authorized supplier.

If you fail to heed these warnings your chair may fail and cause severe injury to the rider or others.
