We know you will be pleased with the quality, performance, and design of your *VARILITE*® product. *VARILITE*® systems offer unparalleled pressure relief,



stability, and positioning support to enhance function and performance. At 49 Inc., Bespoke would be pleased to offer sample product to pressure map or test against any product in the marketplace.

VARILITE® products are virtually maintenance free. To ensure optimal performance, *VARILITE®* suggests that you leave the valve open and allow your cushion or back to fully inflate overnight at least once a week to maintain foam integrity.

VARILITE® cushions and covers should be used in conjunction with one another. The cover is an essential part of the cushion by enhancing pressure distribution and promoting air circulation for healthy tissues. The cover serves to protect the cushion from punctures, burns, and being soiled.

In the rare circumstance where you have punctured the cushion or have broken the valve, they are able to be patched and valves may be replaced. These are stock items and available for immediate shipping.

VARILITE® cushions have a two year limited warranty which may be discussed with your local provider; please ensure that you send in your warranty registration card that came with your product or simply go on-line and complete it: www.varilite.com/forms_warrantyreg.aspx

PSV (Pressure Setting Valve) provides an opportunity to

fix the immersion at levels 1, 2, or 3 depending on what you prefer and what works best for you. The standard valve, which is smaller, may be set this way: Begin with the cushion fully inflated with the valve closed. Transfer on and sit in the proper position. Turn the valve counter clockwise to open the valve and release air. You want to sink down about 1 to 2 inches (2.5cm to 5cm). Close the valve when the air level provides the support you need for comfort and functionality. Generally, this is when there is between 1 and 1/2 in. (2.5 and 1.3cm) of cushion between your ischial tuberosity and the seating surface.
