Valentine Gala



The Canadian Foundation for Physically Disabled Persons (CFPDP) led by the Honourable Vim Kochhar, Chairman, will be hosting the 31st Great Valentine Gala at the Westin Harbour Castle in downtown Toronto.

The CFPDP picked up the torch for the Paralympic movement in 1984

from Dr. Bob Jackson. That year Paralympian's won 222 medals and were 2nd in the world, but it was the media's best kept secret. The event was described as the "crippled athlete" games. The CFPDP organized a Valentines Gala in February 1985 to recognize each medal winner and the Lt. Governor of Ontario the Honourable John Black Aird presented special plaques in front of over 1,000 Toronto corporate leaders, raising over \$239,000.

For the last 31 years, the CFPDP name has become synonymous with the Paralympics and the Valentine Gala, celebrating Paralympian's achievements! Highlights are:

Great Valentine Galas: Since 1985, Paralympian's have been recognized at each of our 30 Great Valentine Galas.

WhyNot Marathon: In 1996, the WhyNot Marathon carried a torch from coast to coast, travelling through more than 600 communities; more than 400 Rotary Clubs in Canada participated.

Helping Canadian Paralympic Committee (CPC): The CFPDP has assisted CPC throughout its existence. When in 2000 there was urgent need for CPC to send our team to Australia, we contributed \$100,000 for emergency assistance.

Podium Fund: 12 years ago the CFPDP created the Podium Fund to present funds to each medal winner at the winter and summer Paralympics and to recognize them with King Clancy Awards.

Rolling Rampage: 10 years ago the CFPDP created the Rolling Rampage 10K wheelchair races with a prize purse of \$35,000, among the largest in the world. On October 7, 2014 the 10th Annual Rolling Rampage, held on Parliament Hill in Ottawa, was attended by over 2500 students from elementary schools and over 300 Parliamentarians and their staff. It helped to educate the students and MPs to the power of Paralympic sport.

Canadian Disability Hall of Fame: The Canadian Disability Hall of Fame has been operating for 21 years and every year one Paralympic athlete is inducted who has made an outstanding contribution.

1776 Step Climb by Wheelchair: In 2002, we organized Paralympian Jeff Adams' 1776 step climb by wheelchair to the top of the CN Tower. This incredible effort raised more than \$170,000 to create a school outreach program.

Corporate Awards: In the last 20 years, the CFPDP has recognized many companies with Corporate Awards for their outstanding contribution to the Paralympic movement.


Ki Mobility Focus CR


