The Next Chapter

Hosted by the University of Pittsburg, the 2015 International Seating Symposium (ISS) was on at the Gaylord Opryland Hotel and Convention Center in Nashville, TN (February 24-28). Titled "The Next Chapter" ISS considers itself the

lead educational and scientific conference in the field of wheelchair seating & mobility and related technologies. The 31st ISS played host to over 1800 people from around the world who participated in 40 sessions that included pre-symposium workshops, plenary sessions, instructional courses, papers, posters, and manufacturer product demonstrations.

With over 100,000 square feet of Exhibition Space, 115 product exhibits and services wowed the folks from (February 25-27) and Ki Mobility's booth 512 and VARILITE 506 were active from all accounts. The Exhibit Hall was open a full-day early to Consumers and Attendees on February 25 during pre-conference Wednesday, workshops and I understand was very much appreciated by the people in and around Nashville. In comparison to the much smaller space at the Vancouver edition of this show, I think exhibitors and attendee's have a greater appreciation for Nashville.
