ParaPan Games



The Parapan Games started in 1999 in Mexico City when the inaugural edition was held with 1,000 athletes

from 18 countries competing in four sports. I would have to research to find out what all the other games were called that brought the America's together but I remember the games in Mexico in 1975 held at the site of the 1968 Olympic Games. There were people selling their children outside the locked gates to the village, there was a copper boiler with a never ending feast of baked beans, and we had pink stoppers (pepto bismal and tequila) to keep us ahead of the water treatment and other foods that had an impact on foreign bodies!

These 1999 Games became a regional qualifying event for the 2000 Paralympic Games in Sydney.

The next Games in 2003, Mar del Plata, Argentina, there were 1,500 athletes from 28 countries competing in nine sports. Rio 2007 was a little smaller with 1,150 athletes from 25 countries competed in 10 sports, but it was the first Parapan Am Games to be held in the same city as its Pan Am counterpart, with just one Organizing Committee. Guadalajara 2011 saw the games grow again to 1,300 athletes from 26 countries competing in 13 sports.

The scope of Toronto 2015 Parapan Am Games has grown. An additional Day was added and there are 1,608 athletes from 28 countries competing in 15 sports.

We wish the competitors, coaches, administrators, volunteers, and everyone else all the best for their time in Toronto and when time allows to relax and see the sites, there is an RGK chair waiting for you at the top of the CN Tower!


