MDEL Balloons Past \$9K

What good is a Medical Device Establishment License (MDEL)? Well, apart from it's ballooning cost (over \$9,000.00 annually going up 2% per year because ... they can...) it gives a properly constituted business the opportunity to manufacturer and sell, import and sell, distribute and sell, classes of medical devices. The safety and effectiveness of medical devices are regulated under the Food and Drugs Act administered by Health Canada and they have historically done audits every four years. We have just finished one of those audits under this process and we have had to clarify the wording and include steps to ensure we are compliant with their rules and regulations which have been written well for companies with products



that are always in the realm of being scrutinized for health and safety to ensure the safe use of products for all Canadians. A humorous start to this quadrennial audit seemed befitting to me and did put some levity into the whole process. I suggested that we were not going to go the route of signing an application to renew our Medical Device Establishment License (MDEL) this year as I felt we could make a better deal with the Hells Angels to look after our needs, after all, they were one of my better half's first sponsors when she got involved in wheelchair basketball.

We were pleased with the recent process and time spent by their department to assist us and we were appreciative to learn that a new fee structure is to be implemented in 2021 with the annual administration fee being reduced to a particular sum which should come in somewhere near half of the current fees. Unfortunately, as it seems all good news comes with a qualification, the quadrennial audit will now be done as Health Canada determines and that will be billed back separately. One step forward, two steps back, the cost of your product will not likely go down in price!

MS Group, with headquarters in Gothenburg, Sweden, has an annual turnover of EUR 55m and employs 475 persons. MS Group AB is a subsidiary of Latour Industries, which is one of five wholly owned business areas within the Latour Group.

In speaking with Mauritz Salin, CEO MS Group AB, he relayed, Latour, with \$9 Billion plus value, "is focused on a long term growth approach with the companies they have in their portfolio and the MS Group AB is focused on being motion system experts supporting OEM and distributors around the world enhancing the global mobility rehab industry."

Pau Bach, founder, principal who sold his shares in Batec-Mobility, and CEO, said, "we are proud what we have achieved with Batec-Mobility and also that we have found a professional long term industrial owner who is committed to develop the company further!" The worldwide distribution structure remains the same and will be business as usual. Batec-Mobility, who may be the only ISO company involved in the front power add-on business, is poised for growth with such tremendous human and financial resources behind them. We look forward to the Batec Management Team staying the same, product continuing to evolve in the same facility, and with the same "developed by and for people with a disability culture" who wear it on their sleeve to drive developments!

My 5 Years is Up ADP

Although there are similar rules and regulations in most jurisdictions in Canada, the Ontario Assistive Devices Program (ADP) may assist an eligible applicant to purchase a wheelchair every five years if their existing device can no longer be used at all, no longer meets the persons basic needs, or can only be used as a back up because of its physical condition. We hear all the time that "I have waited five years I am eligible for a new chair" which is certainly not the case. Naturally, there are other extenuating circumstances like a change in functional mobility, change in body size, a need for modifications or adjustments, the current chair is totalled or whatever, but that would be the exception and not the rule. Frankly, if a person gets a good fitting unit and they maintain it, they will not want to change for more than five years. However, if change is required and it has not been five years since the last unit, ADP may still assist on a prorated basis. ADP Funding is not available if the manufacturer's warranty is in effect.
